

# Residual waste

## Contains:

Waste that cannot be recovered or recycled, e.g.

- Cigarette butts, ashes
- Cat litter
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Disposable nappies, sanitary products
- Broken china and ceramics
- Dry emulsion paints



## DO NOT THROW IN:

Recyclable waste such as wearable clothing and shoes, packaging (glassware, metal, plastic materials, cardboard) as well as biological waste and toxic waste.

# Used paper

## Contains:

- Newspapers, flyers, magazines
- Books, catalogues
- Writing paper, ad mail
- Notebooks and files
- Cardboard cases, corrugated cardboard
- Cardboard cases (folded)
- Egg cartons
- Other clean paper



## DO NOT THROW IN:

Wallpaper, tissue handkerchiefs, sanitary products, disposable nappies, packaging (milk, juice, frozen foods etc.), carbon paper, coated paper or board.

# Biological waste

## Contains:

- Vegetable and fruit scraps
- Food waste, meat and fish (even cooked) as well as spoilt food without packaging
- Bread and cakes/cookies scraps
- Eggshells and nutshells
- Coffee grounds and filter bags
- Tealeaves and teabags
- Leaves, hedge trimmings and grass cuttings
- Flowers, potted plants
- Newspaper used as wrapping



## DO NOT THROW IN:

Disposable nappies, cat and other pet litter, vacuum cleaner bags, cigarette butts and ashes, packaging, residual waste, toxic waste, bones, plastic rubbish bags.
